Value Education



House Activity

The house system in the school occupies prominent place and plays an important role in the furtherance of cultural and co-curricular activities in the school. Every student is allotted a particular house as soon he/she is admitted to the school. The school has four houses named traditionally - Ashoka, Raman, Tagore and Shivaji with the house in-charge of each house. The idea of the system is to inculcate a sense of competition, cooperation, identity and belongingness. To instill a true sense of leadership, students are given administrative responsibilities such as house captains, vice captains and perfects for the activities. Captains have four broad functions: Assembly, Cleanliness, Display and Discipline.

Hostel Facility

The aim of providing residential facilities at G1S is to provide an environment conducive to study, service and resource that facilitate academic achievements. The accommodation for boys and girls is separate. Beds are available on twin sharing basis. The dormitory is A.C. The facilities include common rooms, indoor and outdoor sports.



ADMISSION

The admission is granted for Classes Nursery to Class XI subject to vacancy existing in particular class. The applicant seeking admission needs to get his/her name registered with school during first week of January. The admission test is conducted on second Sunday of Feb/March at 9:00 AM. The registration form can be had from school office from January onwards to February 10th.

Registration forms for the admission will be issued on the dates announced in advance provided vacancy in particular class exists. Pupils applying for admission are as a rule subject to an entrance test. They are tested in syllabus/courses in the standard below the one to which they seek admission.

Parents applying for the withdrawal for their ward after the 10th of the month will have to pay the fees for the NEXT MONTH ALSO. Transfer Certificate will not be issued unless all dues are cleared.

The boarders will pay fee for 12 months. No student is allowed to convert from Boarders to Day scholars. In case he/she wishes to change will have to pay full boarding fee.

Post Admission Procedure

Once admission is granted you may proceed to deposit the fee and submit the following.

- · Three passport size photographs of student
- · One photograph of local or authorized guardian
- · Three passport size photograph of each parent
- Photocopy of all achievement certificates /T.C. in original with mark sheet of last examination
 If the parents would like to withdraw the child after the admission taken, fee will be forfeited by the school.
