**1 Case study**

During the winter holidays, Aarav's cousin Raju came from his village to stay at Aarav's house in Haldwani city. It was winter season, and Raju observed many differences between village life and city life during winter.

In the village, Raju was used to waking up early. During winter, village people sit near a bonfire to keep themselves warm. They wear woollen shawls and caps and drink hot tea. Even in cold weather, villagers feed animals, work in fields, and collect firewood. In the evening, they sit together, talk to each other, and listen to elders' stories.

In the city, Raju noticed that people wake up late during winter holidays. They wear sweaters and jackets, use heaters and blankets, and stay inside their homes to keep warm. Children spend more time watching television, using mobile phones, or playing indoor games. City people travel in cars and buses and rarely sit outside in the cold.

Raju understood that village life in winter is simple and close to nature, while city life is comfortable and modern. Both ways of life help people stay safe and warm during winter.
